The Broward Sheriff's Advisory Council is a non-profit organization devoted to supporting public safety initiatives and first responders. We also partner with other agencies to provide critical training, such as Suicide Prevention for First Responders.

Cassandra Evans - The Department of Juvenile Justice would like to announce that availability of information for law enforcement. A report of all youth who are on community supervision is now readily available. It will include youth who are classified as high risk or moderate-high risk to reoffend and may also have the classification of prolific offender. She will bring sample reports. Afterwards, she would then like to send an email blast via BCCPA requesting that those agencies who would like the information, need to send her their contact information.
