Ron Aronson and Ann Beal – **Consultants for IMCS – speaking about Florida’s First Responder Legislation** - As of October 1, 2018, Florida’s First Responders are eligible to receive full workers’ compensation benefits for PTSD. The March 2018 Florida Senate legislation approval means First Responders may be entitled to lost wages under the Florida workers’ compensation law for PTSD (as defined by SB376).
